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TESTING SCHEDULE

Basic Skills, Wonderlic and TEAS testing is by appointment only at Emerald Coast Technical College main campus. Test dates are listed on the Emerald Coast Technical College calendar website (www.ectc.edu)

You must pre-register as we do not take walk-ins. Required picture identification and social security card must be presented at time of testing.
