Expectations for Students

Parking on ECTC's campus is a privilege, not a right. Any reckless driving or violation of expectations may cause the parking permit to be suspended which is determined by the Principal/Administration.

Students who operate a vehicle, including a motorcycle, on campus **MUST** observe the following rules:

- All vehicles must have a parking permit prominently displayed on the driver's rear window. Motorcycle operators must be able to readily access appropriate approval permits.
- Parking permits are issued by the receptionist/secretary, building 100. Students wishing to purchase a parking permit must present a current copy of the vehicle registration, proof of insurance (insurance card), and the student's driver's license along with the required \$10.00 parking permit fee and completed parking permit application form.
- Students must obey all posted rules and speed limits on campus. Unless otherwise posted, the speed limit on campus is 5 miles per hour.
- Students should park in spaces designated for student parking.
- To provide for student safety, students are not permitted to loiter in parking areas.
- Students should observe all safety precautions, including locking vehicles.
- Students should refrain from playing a radio or other sound equipment in an excessively loud manner.
- Student vehicles may be subject to search by law enforcement officials
